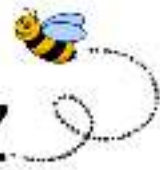

## COA Van Services

COA van services are available to Boxborough residents age 60 or older, and to adults with disabilities age 18 and older. Rides are offered **Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, 9:30 AM to 3:30 PM**. The van travels to towns bordering Boxborough and may be used for medical appointments and local errands for \$1 each way. Medical rides to Concord are \$1 each way. Medical rides to other towns are subject to availability and rates are based on distance. To book a ride, call 978-264-1730, preferably 2 days in advance.

We offer Boxborough seniors and disabled adults transportation, through our **Go Boxborough!** program, to medical appointments that are outside the service area, time, or availability of our van. **Boxborough Tree Lighting**

Boxborough’s Public Ceremonies and Celebrations Committee (PCCC) will hold the 2023 Tree Lighting Ceremony on **Saturday, December 2 at 4:30 PM**. A special guest will turn on the tree lights, followed by a performance by the Blanchard School Brass Ensemble and the Blanchard Choir. Santa will arrive around **4:45 PM**, after which light refreshments will be served under the tent at the Boxborough Museum.

The event is held at the intersection of **Middle and Hill Roads** and will take place rain or shine. This intersection will be closed to traffic around 4 PM, and road closure signs will indicate where parking is allowed, as well as where it is not allowed. Please obey the signs and park only in the areas designated for parking. The PCCC hopes you will join with family, friends, and neighbors to enjoy this special event.

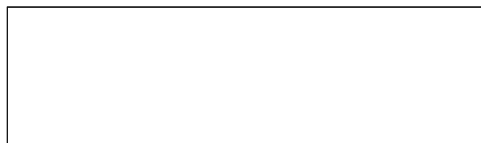
