Public Safety News

The Boxborough Fire Department participates in the Commonwealth's Senior SAFE Program. Coordinated by Capt. Jason Malinowski, the program offers the following free services to Boxborough homeowners who are at least 65 years old:

- Home safety inspections.
- Smoke and carbon monoxide (CO) detector battery replacement.
- Provision/replacement of certain detection devices when in stock. Note this applies only to battery-powered devices, not those requiring hard wiring.
- Provision of key boxes to be placed on home exteriors for access by emergency services. Fire and police are the only ones with code access to the boxes.
- Checks that houses are properly numbered to assist emergency personnel with locating the house in the event of an emergency.

To schedule a Senior SAFE home inspection, please call the Fire Department's non-emergency phone number at 978-264-1770 or email jmalinowski@boxborough-ma.gov. These home inspections are conducted by on-duty personnel, which means that they may be delayed in the event of an emergency call.

The van travels to towns bordering Boxborough and may be used for medical appointments and local errands for \$1 each way. Medical rides to Concord are \$1 each way. 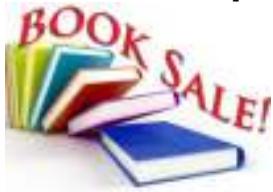
