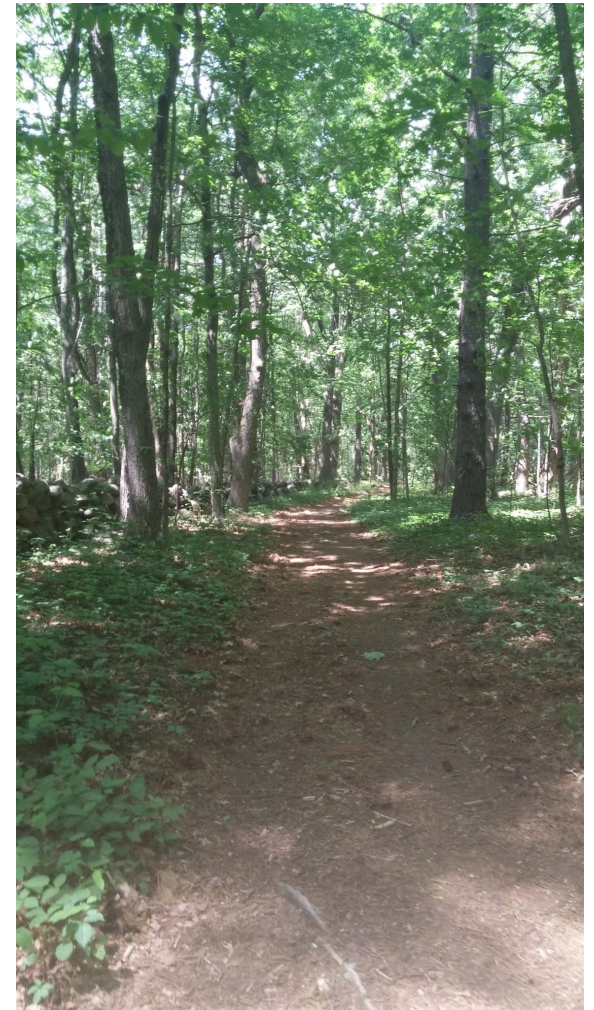
Good Trail Manners (Leave No Trace)
