Senior Property Tax Work-Off Abatement Application

Please note: Taxpayer must be over the age of sixty by the July 1st preceding the start of the program year and must reside at the location to which the abatement is being applied. Taxpayer must have resided in Boxborough for at least 1 (one) year. Parcels with multiple owners - all owners of a parcel may receive abatements under the program if they otherwise qualify. Participants may be credited with up to 125 hours at the current state minimum wage.

The amount of your property tax abatement is considered income and you will receive a W2 from the Town at the end of the year.
