

Boxborough Council on Aging Transportation Services

The Boxborough Council on Aging offers two transportation options for seniors age 60 and up as well as adults with disabilities age 18 and up, with door to door service.

The Montachusett Regional Transit Authority (MART) van operates on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 9:30 AM until 3:30 PM. This van provides transportation to destinations in Boxborough, Acton, Littleton, Harvard and Stow for medical appointments, shopping and other errands for \$1 each way.

It also provides transportation for medical appointments to:

- Concord for \$1 each way
- Ayer, Groton, Hudson, Maynard and Westford for \$3 each way
- Leominster, Marlboro, Sudbury for \$5 each way
- Burlington, Lexington, Lowell, Waltham for \$10 each way

The Go Boxborough! program provides transportation for medical appointments that are outside the service area, time or availability of our MART van. This service is available Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 3:30 PM at the same rates of the MART van. In addition, it can provide transportation to Boston and Worcester medical appointments for \$20 each way. We currently use Destination Express, Inc. for transportation by passenger vehicles and Gentle Arms Daily, LLC for handicapped, medical van transportation.

Requests for all reservations must be made at least 48 hours in advance. Local MART rides can be reserved one week in advance. Reservations for rides to medical appointments can be made one month in advance. Reservations for rides to medical appointments take priority over local errands.
